

# BRIEFLY LEGAL AND COMMISSIOIN NOTE Keeping Records and New License Law App for Mobile Devices

## **TODAY'S QUESTION**

How long do I have to keep files?

#### **ANSWER**

3 years. Section 34-27-36(a)(8)c. requires that you must keep a complete record of funds belonging to others showing to whom the money belongs, date deposited, date of withdrawal, and other pertinent information for 3 years.

Also, Section 34-27-36(a)(31) requires that a qualifying broker or company must keep in their files all contracts, leases, listings, and other records pertinent to a real estate transaction for a period of 3 years. (Remember that records for transactions that never close must also be kept under this section.)

# **NEXT QUESTION**

Can I keep my files electronically?

# **ANSWER**

Yes. Please keep in mind that you are still responsible for producing these when needed. If you use electronic storage, consider placing your files additionally in a backup storage. If you cannot produce a document you stored electronically, the commission will treat it as if you never had it.
